Water - Origin and Elixir of Life

Like the planet Earth, the human body consists of nearly 80% water. Water gives life and is an element of nature. In the last century, it was still treated as a common good, whereas today it is seen as an economic commodity.

Water is more than an element – it is a bearer of life, a medium of evolution, and a mirror of our cultural history.

In this interdisciplinary workshop, we explore the role of water as the origin of biological processes, as a mythological symbol, and as a critical resource in times of climate change. Other global challenges are also discussed, such as access to water as a human right, as a factor of peace or war, and as a health-promoting instrument.
